It is time to get your application packets ready for the Spring State Convention in April. There are two types of scholarships available: academic and service. Merced College VSP chapter may send <u>two</u> candidates for the academic scholarships and <u>two</u> candidates for the service scholarships. You may apply to be selected to compete for both academic and service scholarships.

Minimum requirements to apply:

Academic scholarship requirements:

- 60 community college units completed by the end of Spring 2020 semester
- Membership in AGS during Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 semesters
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.75
- Minimum Fall 2019 semester GPA of 3.0
- Attendance at the AGS Spring Convention in Sacramento, April 24-26th

Service scholarship requirements:

- 30 community college units completed by the end of Spring 2020 semester
- Membership in AGS during Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 semesters
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Minimum Fall 2019 semester GPA of 3.0
- Attendance at the AGS Spring Convention in Sacramento, April 24-26th

The advisor, along with a committee of outside readers, will select the three members to compete at the state-level. This is what we need from you:

1. **For an academic scholarship**: A two-page, double-spaced, typed autobiographical essay that includes the applicant's academic achievements and goals.

For a service scholarship: A two-page, double spaced, typed statement describing the applicant's service to the chapter, the college, and the community, *and* how this service has benefited the applicant. Attach a list of the applicant's service to AGS, the campus, and the community that includes semester dates of service.

- 2. Unofficial transcripts to show completed courses, Fall 2019 semester GPA, and cumulative GPA.
- 3. A printout of the candidate's courses in progress.

Deadline: Thursday, March 5th by noon in Jennifer McBride's office.

Announcement of selection of candidates: Monday, March 9th via email.
